# Supporting Our Community For Over 100 Years



## Dear Neighbors:

I want to start by thanking all of you who have supported The Community Fund of BET. Your contributions truly make a difference – and without you, The Community Fund could not exist.

The Community Fund has had a busy year. A few highlights are listed below:

### **Diverting funds to those in need:**

As you will see documented in this Annual Report, The Community Fund has touched all ages and areas in our community. We provided \$486,351 to 21 senior organizations, youth organizations, family organizations and health care organizations. These grants allow these organizations to provide important services which meet the most critical of needs in our community.

### **Strategic guidance to agencies:**

We provided more than just monetary support. The Community Fund helped agencies coordinate during the pandemic and learn from each other as they pivoted to online and alternative programming.

### **Continued implementation of strategic plan:**

Last year we completed a strategic plan which provides a roadmap to shape the future direction of the fund. We are in our first year of implementing that multi-year plan. As part of the Strategic Plan:

- We have a revised mission and vision statement;
- We are looking at our evaluation process to ensure we continue to allocate our dollars wisely;
- We are revamping the board to ensure maximum effectiveness; and
- We are modernizing our fundraising to make it as easy as possible to donate.

### **Needs assessment survey:**

We are nearing the completion of a needs assessment survey we are performing with PACE University. Preliminary drafts of the survey are helping us quantitatively identify the most pressing needs in our community. We believe this survey will help guide the revamp of our grant allocation process over the course of the next couple of years.

As we turn to a new fiscal year, the Board is excited and energized for the work ahead. We plan to push forward on the strategic plan, with the benefit of our needs assessment survey. We are also extremely excited to introduce a new fundraiser for The Community Fund, a 3-on-3 basketball tournament we will be hosting jointly with The Youth Community Fund! All of this while continuing to support the local agencies with which we already work and reaching out to new organizations.

# Local Giving For Lasting Impact



## A FIRST EVER

A Community Needs Assessment will provide The Community Fund of Bronxville, Eastchester and Tuckahoe with data and insights to help pinpoint where the greatest needs are in our community, and which agencies are fulfilling those needs.

The community-engaged research partnership will result in a report that shines a light on the human service issues that affect Bronxville, Eastchester and Tuckahoe residents, businesses, quality of life, and those organizations that deliver critical programs and services to the community.

# New Initiatives for The Community Fund

## Needs Assessment for the Community in partnership with PACE University.

Following a series of planning discussions beginning in 2021, we have embarked on a year-long Community Needs Assessment lead by Pace University faculty in collaboration with students and staff.

### ■ Community Demographic Profile and Resource Mapping

Pace has developed a comprehensive demographic profile of Bronxville, Tuckahoe and Eastchester areas through the use of local and U.S. Census data. The team will also create an interactive map of the human and social service organizations in our area.

### ■ Community Survey

A key component of the Community Needs Assessment is the community survey. The survey is comprised of 54 questions covering five key community service areas: (1) basic human needs; (2) community services; (3) crisis and disaster services; (4) families, children and seniors; and (5) mental and physical health. The survey was developed with input

from local leaders and officials and was distributed between March and August to all residents in both electronic and paper format. Approximately 556 residents and local employees participated in the survey.

### ■ Interviews

The research team completed 21 interviews with community leaders and key stakeholders – these interviews allow for an in-depth qualitative overview of the various perspectives on priorities and challenges in our area.

### REPORTING

These research streams will culminate in a comprehensive, graphic-designed, printable report with findings disseminated, in partnership with The Community Fund, in a series of public announcements and events in the local community and Westchester County.

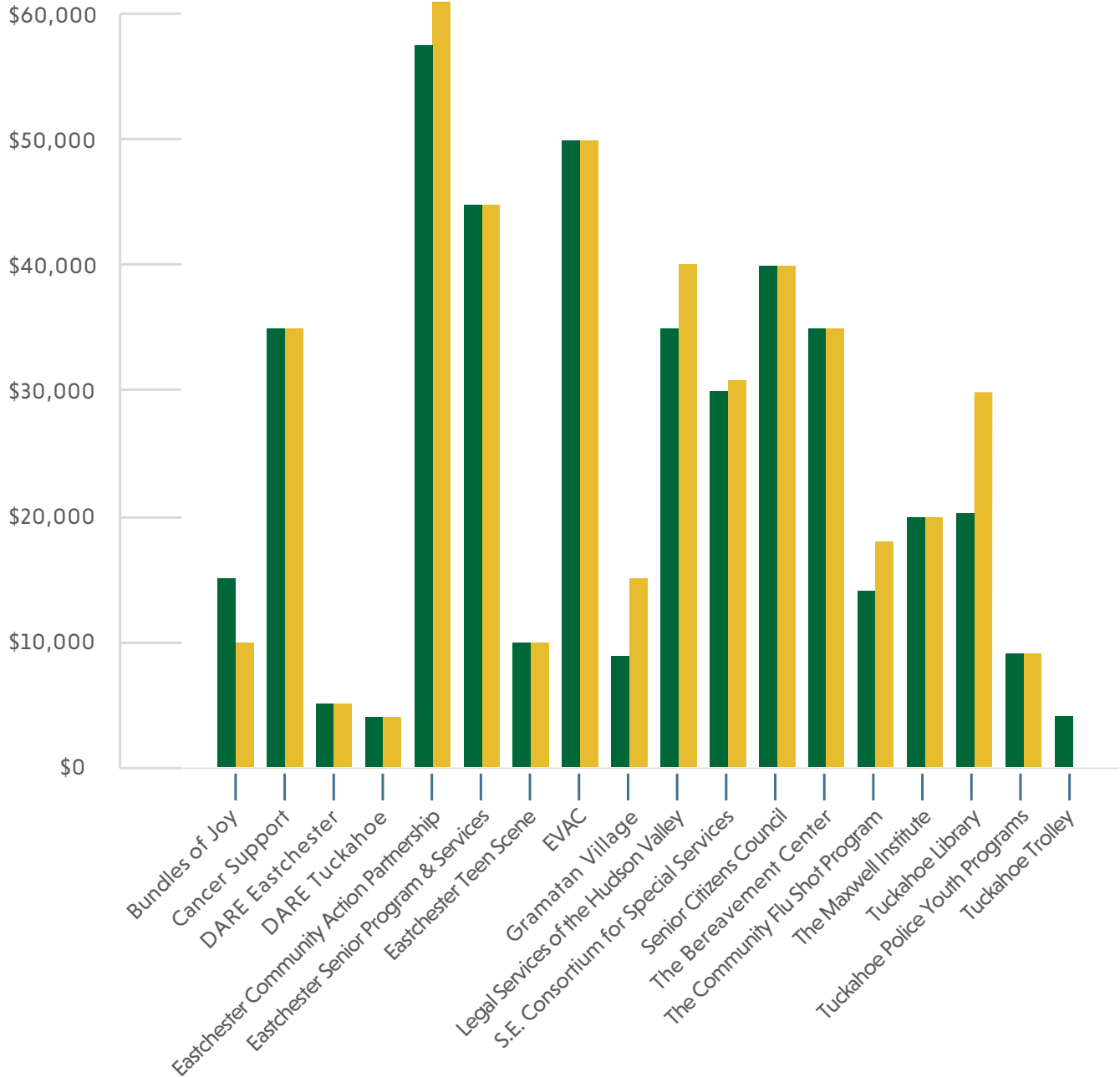

**Total Community Investment FY2022**

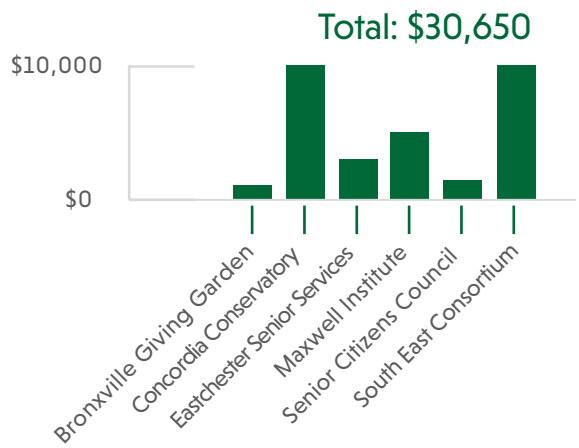

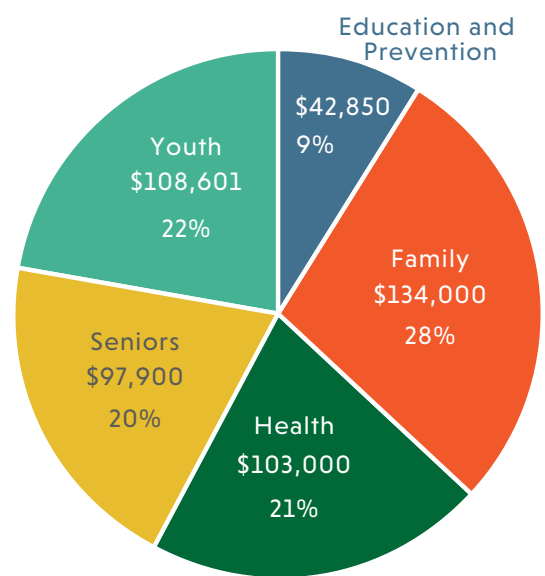

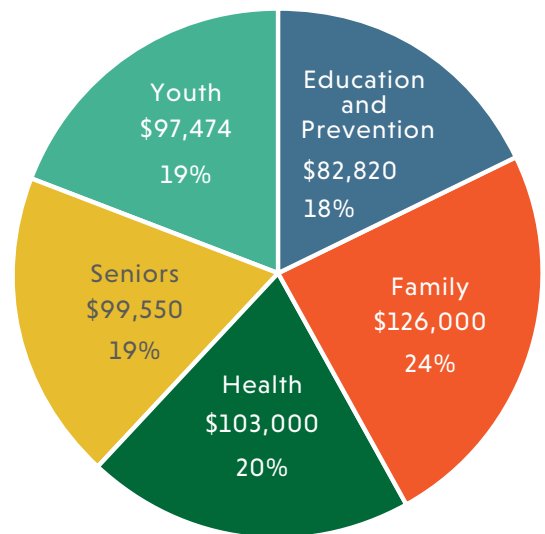
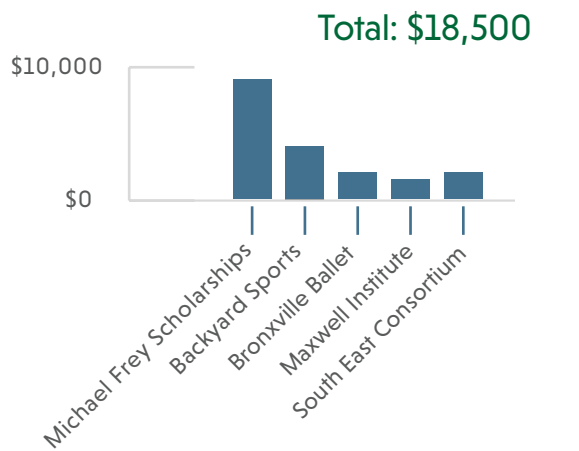


### Community Investments by Demographic Sector FY 2022 and FY 2023

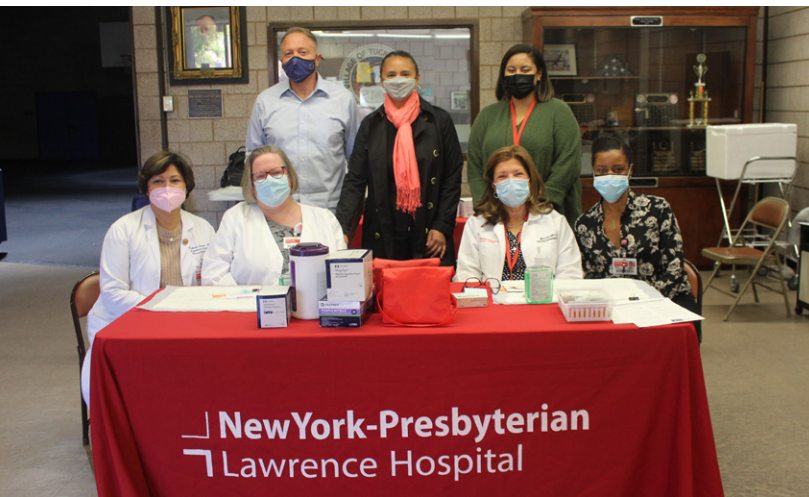

# Our Grant Process



# The Community Fund evaluates grant proposals and designates donor dollars through 3 different grant processes.

This year we were able to harness the power of over 200 volunteers to disperse \$486,351.

## 1. Member Agency Fund Grants

Agencies which receive funding for their operating and administrative budget as well as for program support are considered "Community Fund Member Agencies". Member Agencies are nonprofit organizations and community programs that service the Bronxville, Eastchester, and Tuckahoe communities and fall into 5 Sectors of Impact: Youth, Seniors, Education and Prevention, Family, and Health. Individual grants range from \$2,000 to \$60,000 yearly.

## 2. Discretionary Fund Grants

Discretionary grants are meant to fund either a specific time-limited project/program or provide seed money for a new initiative. Programs in this category are generally funded for one year and a maximum of \$10,000 is dispersed. These one-time grants give the Fund the flexibility to help support an immediate need with an agency or community program, or seed a new initiative that can dramatically impact the lives of our residents. In the last 10 years the fund has given over \$210,000 in this special funding.

## 3. Youth Community Fund Grants

Youth Community Fund grants aimed at supporting local youth initiatives that YCF deems appropriate. Grants are supported through YCF fundraising efforts.

# Youth Community Fund of BET

**With a motto of "Youth Serving Youth," The Youth Community Fund of BET teaches area high school students the value of philanthropy and community service.**

In 2021-22, The Youth Community Fund welcomed more than 110 members and raised \$9,500 from membership dues and fundraising efforts. Throughout the year, YCF members organized and participated in community service events, volunteer opportunities, and fundraising drives, all with a focus on serving the needs of vulnerable youth in our area.

Similar to The Community Fund, YCF awards community grants each year with the funds it raises. Students solicit and evaluate grant applications, make recommendations for funding, and then vote as a group for those grantees that will make the greatest impact. After a thorough review process, YCF grants were awarded to four local agencies in the spring of 2022: Backyard Sports Cares, Bronxville Ballet NOT FOR SALE, The Maxwell Institute, and the South East Consortium for Special Services.

YCF volunteers participated in several high-impact community service initiatives throughout the year, including the Bundles of Joy's Joyful Closet, the YCF Thanksgiving Diaper Drive, the Town of Eastchester's Winter Festival, the Village of Tuckahoe's Creepy Candy Crawl, the SEC Prom and other socials, ECAP academic tutoring, Bronxville Ballet NOT FOR SALE dance classes, Backyard Sports Cares after-school clinics, and Bronxville, Tuckahoe and Eastchester Police Departments' community outreach events.

YCF members also organized two new events this year: the YCF Paddlefest Fundraiser in February, and the YCF Speakers' Panel on Philanthropy and Social Impact in March. The panel featured student presentations and dynamic guest speakers who discussed career paths in the nonprofit and social impact sectors. Both community events enjoyed a robust turnout.

Now in its fourth year, YCF represents seven area high schools and demonstrates the ability of students to get involved and make an impact right here at home.

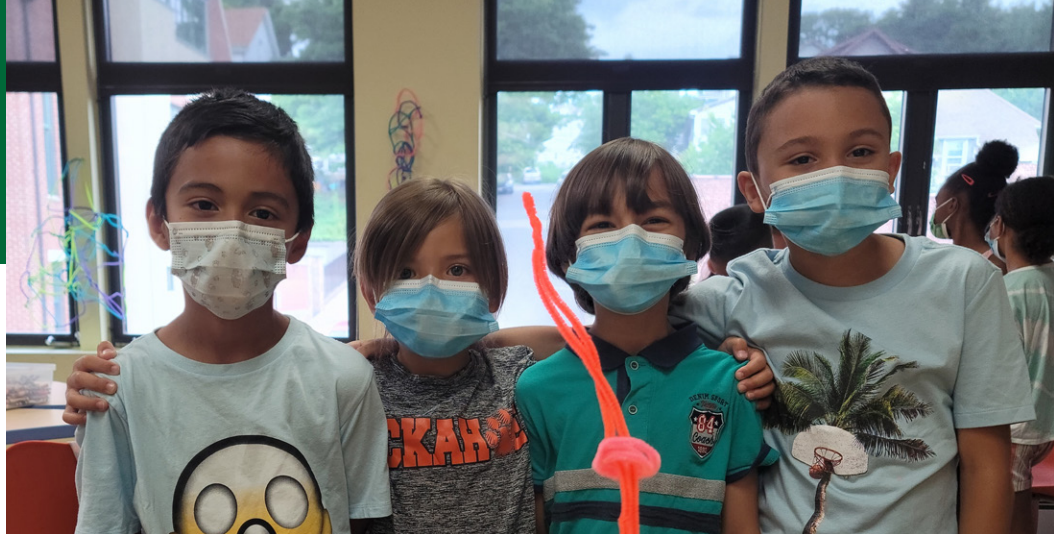
